<i>Why do I need a Degree Audit</i>	To follow through with the requirements for your program
<i>Why do I need a MAP?</i>	To have a plan by term of the classes you must take according to your program
<i>When can I apply for the BAS?</i>	Once you have completed an A.A. or A.S. in Corrections, Fire Science, Law Enforcement, Emergency Administration Management, Emergency Medical Technology, Criminal Justice Technology, or related fields - ask your advisor
<i>What do I need to do to apply for the BAS?</i>	You must apply for the BAS with the Admissions department make sure you declare Florida Residency and Financial Aid for the BAS
<i>How do I know when I am ready to graduate?</i>	You must look into your degree audit and all the areas must mention "Satisfied" - see an Advisor
<i>Where do I go to apply for graduation?</i>	You must go to the Advisement & Career Services of your home campus. For the BAS SOJ you must apply with the North Campus
<i>How can I tell if I have graduated?</i>	You can check your transcripts or see a Career Advisor (you should have received notification of your graduation status)
<i>What is the difference between SOJ Academics and Police Academy?</i>	If you are interested, in becoming a certified police officer you have to contact the Police Academy. If you are interested, in an Associate, Bachelors or Credit College Certificate degree you must contact the SOJ Academics department.
<i>How do I enroll to be a firefighter?</i>	To obtain an information packet and a Firefighter/EMT-Combined packet, please contact the Fire Science Program office: (305) 237-3473 or email firescience@mdc.edu
